Sub: Installation of Rain Water Harvesting Structure and Percolation Tanks - reg.

Installation of Rain Water Harvesting Structures and percolation tanks in the premises of Industries, Resorts, Hotels, etc is essential to conserve and promote use of harvested rain water for daily use other than cooking and drinking water purposes like gardening, etc during lean seasons. Such structures installed for rain water harvesting system may result in incurring less expenditure towards payment of water charges by the industries/resorts/hoteliers in the long run will certainly reduce the loss of rain water due to runoff. The percolation tank so installed will help in ground water recharge and improve the ground water table.

It is enjoined upon all the Industrial units, hoteliers and resorts in Daman and Diu to go for installation of Rainwater harvesting structure including percolation tanks to conserve and effectively use the rainwater.
