 - (b) **deaf and hard of hearing (DH);**
 - (c) **locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular Dystrophy (LD);**
 - (d) **autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness (AID);**
 - (e) **multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deaf- blindness in the posts identified for each disabilities' (MD)**

Scheme

The National Talent Search Examination for students studying in class X is meant to identify and nurture the talent .The examination is conducted every year at two levels : Stage-I(State Level) and Stage-II (National Level).

Scholarships: About one thousand scholarships are awarded for different stages of education as follows:

- (a) Scholarship of Rs.1250/-per month for class XI to XII.
- (b) Scholarship of Rs.2000/-per month for Undergraduates and Post Graduates.
- (c) Amount of scholarship for Ph.D. is fixed in accordance with the UGC norms.

Reservations: At the national level for stage-II Examination 15% for students belonging to the SC category, 7.5% for students belonging to the ST category and 27% for students belonging to OBC category (Non-creamy layer) as per central list available on www.ncbc.nic.in/user_panel/centralliststateview.aspx and 4% for Physically Challenged group of students, with benchmark disabilities of which, one percent each shall be reserved for person with benchmark disabilities under clauses (a), (b) and (c) and one percent for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (d) and (e) namely:

- (a) Blindness and low vision (BLV)
- (b) Deaf and hard of hearing (DH)
- (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy (LD)
- (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness (AID)
- (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness in the posts identified for each disabilities. (MD)

Selection: Stage-I selection will be done by UT and those who are selected /recommended from stage-I examination, will be eligible to appear for stage-II examination, conducted by NCERT.

Qualifying Marks: Qualifying marks for candidates from SC/ST/PH category is 32% in each paper and for other category it is 40% in each paper.

Eligibility: All the students of class X studying in recognized schools are eligible to appear for the stage-I examination, conducted by the States/UTs, in which the schools are located. There will be no domicile restriction.

Students registered under Open Distance Learning (ODL) will also be eligible for scholarship, provided the student is below the age of 18 years (as on 1st July 2018), the student is not employed and he/she is appearing in class examination for the first time

Pattern of Examination: The pattern of written examination will be as follows:

Stage I & II: Examination at the State/ UT level will comprise of two papers i.e.
